To be eligible for field experiences (internship and practicum), students must meet professional expectations described in Human Services Handbook. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for the practicum.

General Education courses are identified in blue.

- 15 credits must be taken at the 300 or 400 level.
- All courses in the student's last 30 credits must be taken at Stevenson.
